Some discount examples

A charitable organisation wants to use the hall for 2½ hours once a month for 4 months, April-July

Charge: $\pm 40/hr \times 2.5$ hours = $\pm 100 \times 4$ sessions = ± 400 Discounts: Charity = 50%; Regular = 20%: Total charge = $\pm 400 - 50\% = \pm 200 - 20\% = \pm 160$ The discounted rate equates to $\pm 16/hr$.

An organisation wants to use the hall for 7 hours every week for 10 sessions

Charge: £40/hr x 4 hours = £160 x 10 sessions = £1600 Discounts: 7 hr reduced to 4 hr maximum charge; Regular = 25% discount: Total charge = £1600 - 25% = £1200 The discounted rate equates to £120/session.

A church Mother and Toddler group wants to use the upper hall for 3 hours every week (term-time)

Charge: $\pm 40/hr \times 3$ hours = $\pm 120/week$ Discounts: Charity = 50%; Regular = 20%: Total charge = $\pm 120 / session - 50\% - 20\% = \pm 48$

A parent using the hall for 3 hours for a child's party

Charge: £40/hr x 3 hours = £120 Discounts: non-profit = 50%: Total charge = £120 - 50% = £60The discounted rate equates to £20/hr.
