#### Maths is Fun, Faith is better

Let's say x = ymultiply both sides by x gives  $x^2 = xy$ subtract  $y^2$  gives  $x^2 - y^2 = xy - y^2$ which is (x + y)(x - y) = y(x - y)divide by (x - y) and we get x + y = yWe started with x = y, so clearly y + y = yDivide by y and we have 1 + 1 = 1. Wait. Did I just prove that 2 = 1?

Most people will immediately say 'that can't be right' and then struggle to explain why.

It's a bit like faith in Jesus – there is no proof that can't be doubted or disputed; and yet we believe. A clergyman recently suggested that doubt is a thing of emotion, suggesting that once the emotion settles faith will return. But I wonder if that's too simple. Surely faith recognises the lack of indisputable proof and believes still – the doubt isn't absent it's just overcome.

God's way has always been that a human relationship with Him is on the basis of faith: "Take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one." Eph 6:16.
