God is Love

"I don't know why we're on this earth," says Stephen. "... But if I wanted to find the answer, I would begin with how much I love you." [Richard Osman's 4th Thursday Murder Club Mystery]

When we stop to think about purpose and what's really important, we usually come back to our relationships, cherishing most those relationships characterised by love. So what is it about love that draws us?

The apostle John tells us (twice – 1 John 4:8 and 16) that God is love, and I wonder if there's a connection between the love-nature of God and the love-desire in our hearts (we are, after all, made in the image of God – Gen1:27)? Richard of St Victor (C12th) argues that God's love can only be perfect if He is three persons: a person who loves; a person who is loved; a person who shares the love of the two. One person alone has no one to love; two persons' love is reciprocal; only with three persons does love become the truly perfect Divine love.

Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. 1John4:8.

Mark 8:31-9:1 (NIV)



³¹ He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. ³² He spoke plainly about this, and Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. ³³ But when Jesus turned and looked at his disciples, he rebuked Peter. "Get behind me, Satan!" he said. "You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns."

³⁴ Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. ³⁵ For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me and for the gospel will save it. ³⁶ What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? ³⁷ Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul? ³⁸ If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels."
